

ROLE DESCRIPTION: REFEREE COVID SUPERVISOR

Role and Purpose of Referee Covid Supervisor

The Referee Covid Supervisor will carry out the day to day monitoring of compliance with protocols and Gaelic Games Safe Return to Play Guidelines for the match officials in their county. This position is expected to be a volunteer role.

Key Responsibilities

- Ensure all appropriate COVID-19 forms are completed and reviewed by match officials before returning to games
- Compile evidence of completion of Return to Activity education module from all officials
- Ensure match officials are aware and adhere to COVID-19 guidance and protocols while at games
- Manage suspected cases of COVID-19 as per guidelines
- Include referees on match official list only when they have completed education and health questionnaire
- Ensure referees have updated health questionnaire prior to all appointments

SUSPECTED CASE RESPONSE PLAN

Initial Response

The Referee Covid Supervisor will be responsible to implementing the response plan to a suspected case once an official identifies themselves to them. The response must be quickly dealt with in a private and confidential manner. If any official, suspects themselves, or is suspected of having symptoms, they must report/be reported to the Referee Covid Supervisor if they have officiated or have accepted any appointments. The Referee Covid Supervisor should then contact the Covid Supervisor of any clubs who have been in close contact with the official.
