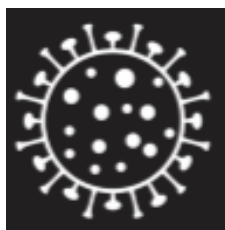

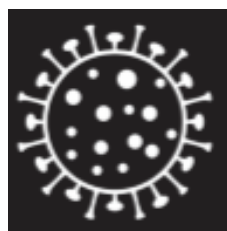

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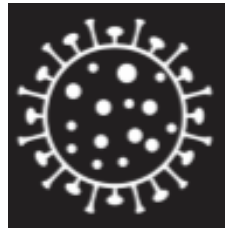

	Is the pitch in good condition and fit for use and free from defects?
